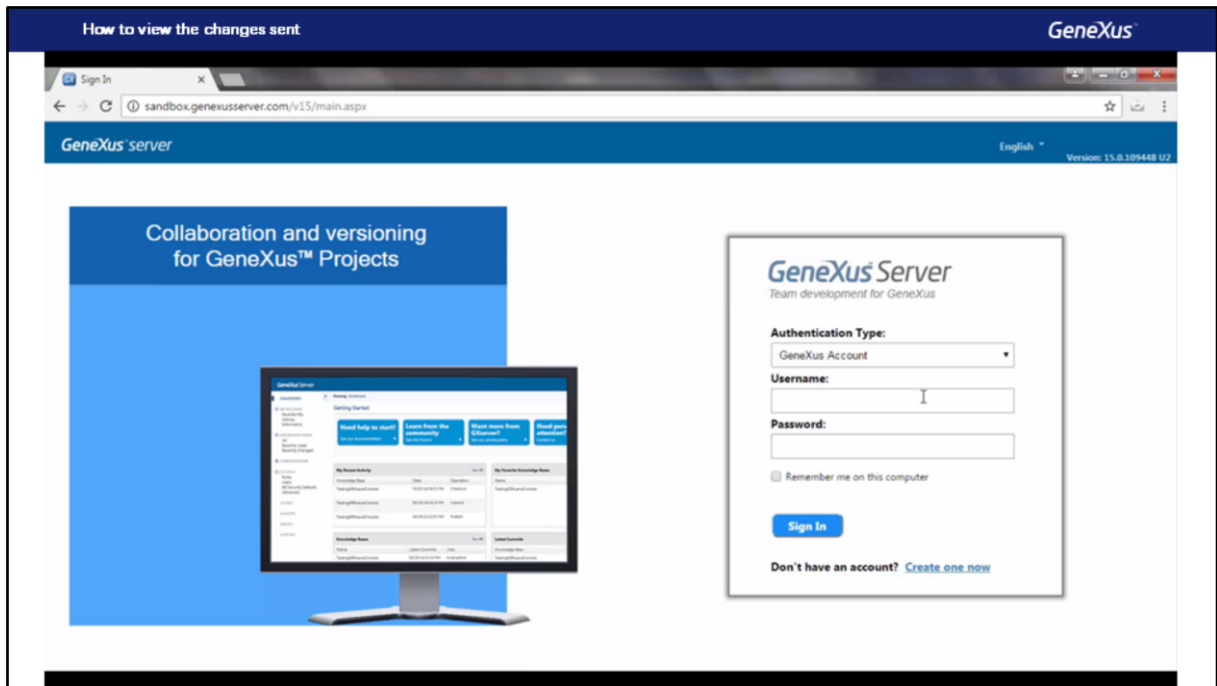


## GeneXus Server

How to view the changes sent

Let's return to the server instance and check whether this knowledge has been effectively integrated into the knowledge existing in the KBWorldCup KB.

We click and start navigating the KB viewer.

From here we check the name of the knowledge base on which we're working, and also the version on which we're working.

We also see the list of the latest revisions with the comments we've entered when running Commit operations.

There's also a chart with general information about the number of objects in the KB, the size of the schema and the non-referenced objects.

Let's select the Knowledge Base option. There's a list of the latest changes made, and also the list of folders in our KB.

From here we can check whether the objects recently sent have been effectively integrated.

We can also make a search. So, we enter the Team pattern and see the search result. All the objects that have the pattern searched for are included.

Now, let's select the Team transaction and see the transaction's properties. Also, we can see all the transaction's components, its structure, the web form, win form, rules section, events, stated variables, and so on.

If we return to the transaction structure and select, for example, the TeamName attribute, the properties are updated, right? And now we're viewing the properties applied to this attribute.

But, remember that we're in the KB viewing environment. From here we will not be able to make any changes.



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
